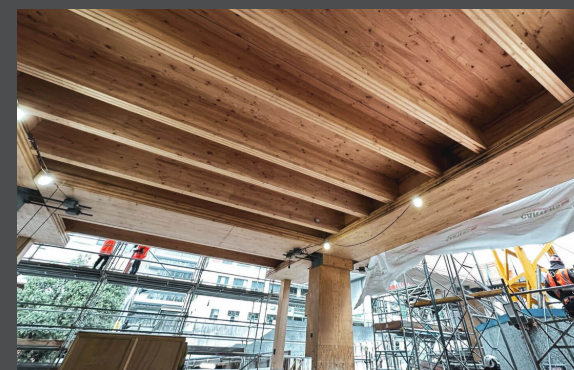

BACKGROUND
